Identify any skill gaps and plan for training or recruitment as necessary

Estimate the costs associated with each initiative and project		
Consider capital expenses (CAPEX) and operational expenses (OPEX)		
Include hardware, software, licensing, training, and ongoing maintenance costs		
Conduct Risk Assessment		
Identify potential risks and obstacles that may hinder the IT roadmap		
Develop contingency plans to mitigate risks and address challenges		
Consider security, compliance, and data privacy concerns		
Build Stakeholder Alignment		
Engage key stakeholders and communicate the IT roadmap vision		
Address concerns and gather input to ensure buy-in and support		
Foster collaboration and involvement from cross-functional teams		
Create a Detailed Project Plan		
Break down each initiative into actionable tasks and sub-tasks		
Define timelines, milestones, and dependencies for each task		
Assign responsibilities to team members and establish reporting mechanisms

Execute the projects according to the project plan		
Track and monitor progress against milestones and KPIs		
Regularly communicate updates to stakeholders and address any issues		
Review & Adapt
